Umbrella fabric material: Polyester Made in China

⚠ Warning

- Be careful not to close the umbrella too vigorously, as the tip of the umbrella can hit others in the eyes.

○ Precautions for use

- Do not use the product outside of its intended application.
- Do not leave in direct sunlight, or in hot and humid areas.
- The edges of the umbrella are sharp. Pay attention to your surroundings when using.
- The umbrella frame grows narrower as it nears the top.
Do not insert your fingers or hands into the umbrella, as this may cause injury.
- The fabric's water repellency will decrease over time.
For prolonged use, spray the umbrella with a water repellent coating.
Note that some coatings may cause discoloration or stains.
- To avoid damage, do not use the umbrella in strong winds.
- While water-repellent, the seams of the fabric may leak in heavy rain and after prolonged use.
- Vigorously rotating the umbrella after use to dry it may damage the handle or locking mechanism.
- The umbrella frame contains glass fiber (plastic with reinforced fiber).
Avoid direct contact in the event that the fiber becomes exposed due to the umbrella breaking or being damaged.
- Avoid use by children.

○ Product Care

- When drying, keep the umbrella out of direct sunlight.
Direct exposure to sunlight may cause fading or changes to the surface.
- When storing, keep slightly open to allow for sufficient air flow.
Storing while wet or insufficiently dry may cause the frame to rust, or the fabric to discolor or change.
